AFFIDAVIT OF

I, [REDACTED], of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, make oath and say as follows:

1. I have personal knowledge of the matters and facts deposed to in this affidavit, except where stated to be on information learned from someone else and where that is stated, I believe the information to be true.
2. I am the mother of [REDACTED], an above named defendant. I am also the grandmother of Baby Doe. AS a result of discussion with [REDACTED], it is my understanding and belief that my daughter, [REDACTED], released Baby Doe from the Royal University Hospital on or about April 30, 2006, in the care of [REDACTED], sister to [REDACTED], who as director of Montreal Lake Child and Family Services, placed the child with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], by prior agreement between [REDACTED].

3. I had many discussions with my daughter prior to Baby Doe's birth, during which [REDACTED] spoke of her reluctance to raise the child herself. I currently have custody of [REDACTED]'s first born child. She has been in my care for the past 8 years. She is currently 8 ½ years old. [REDACTED] continues to struggle with substance abuse issues and is not ready or able to resume the custody and care of her eldest child.

4. I observed many occasions during [REDACTED]'s pregnancy where she could have told the Petitioner about the baby, and specifically that he was the father. However, [REDACTED] declined, despite having told me on a number of occasions that she was planning to tell the Petitioner that he was the father of her child.

5. It is my belief that the Petitioner would be a loving parent to Baby Doe. Upon his discovery of my daughter's pregnancy, the Petitioner immediately expressed to me a wish to be part of his child's life. I had several opportunities to observe the Petitioner's manner of relating to my daughter, [REDACTED], on a first-hand basis. The Petitioner was consistently affectionate and polite to both [REDACTED] and myself. [REDACTED] spoke highly of the Petitioner prior to the end of their relationship.

6. I make this affidavit in support of the Petitioner's motion for custody, visitation, and a declaration of paternity in his favour.
