I, [REDACTED], of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, make oath and say as follows:

1. I am the Applicant (Respondent) in this proceeding and I have personal knowledge of the matters and facts deposed to in this affidavit, except where stated to be on information learned from someone else and where that is stated, I believe the information to be true.
2. On October 4, 2006, the Honourable Mr. Justice R. S. Smith ordered in F.L.D. Chambers that I was to have visitation with son on a weekly basis. This order was not implemented despite my efforts and the efforts of my solicitors. In order

to meet my son for the first time, I instructed my solicitors to prepare a motion addressing access, *inter alia*.

3. My solicitors returned the matter to Chambers on October 25, 2006, leading to the decision made by the Honourable Madam Justice J. A. Ryan-Froslic of that same date, which is under-appeal, and which further specified and implemented the terms of the earlier order regarding my visitation with my son.
4. I make this affidavit in support of my application to lift the stay of execution in order that my access to my son be according to the provisions of the October 25, 2006, decision of Madam Justice J. A. Ryan-Froslic.
