I, [REDACTED], of the City of Saskatoon, in the Province of Saskatchewan, make oath and say as follows:

1. I am the Petitioner in this proceeding and I have personal knowledge of the matters and facts deposed to in this affidavit, except where stated to be on information learned from someone else and where that is stated, I believe the information to be true.
2. On November 8, 2006, my fiancée and I attended at the Family Services facility in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan to participate in the first half of the Parenting Education Program. The second half was to take place the following evening, November 9, 2006.

3. I attended the first half of the seminar and during the break I had a conversation with an old acquaintance of mine, Mr. Joe Blatz, who was the instructor that evening. I asked him if he thought the course was beneficial in my circumstances. Mr. Blatz advised me that he felt that this course would be of no benefit to me as I am not in a position to co-parent in a post separation relationship with my son's mother, which I verily believe to be true.
4. Given this advice my fiancée and I left the program and did not return the next night for the second portion.
5. I make this affidavit in support of *ex parte* application exempting me from the requirement to attend a parenting education program.
