DRAFT NOTICE OF THIRD PARTY CLAIM

TAKE NOTICE that the Petitioner has commenced an action against the Respondents, [REDACTED], The Minister of Community Resources for Saskatchewan and the Saskatoon Regional Health Authority, and a copy of the Petitioner's Petition is served herewith:

AND TAKE NOTICE that the Petitioner claims to be entitled to relief against you on the grounds set out in this Third Party Claim. If you wish to dispute the Petitioner's claim against the Respondent, or your liability to the Petitioner you shall deliver your Third Party Defence within 20 days after the day of service of this Third Party Claim on you.

AND TAKE NOTICE that if you fail to do so, you are liable to have judgment entered against you pursuant to the Rules of Court without further notice to you.

THIRD PARTY CLAIM

1. The Petitioner, [REDACTED], asserts this claim against the third party Respondents, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], of Prince Albert in the Province of Saskatchewan.
2. The Respondent, [REDACTED], gave birth to a child on or about [REDACTED], 2006, and subsequently gave care and custody of that child to the third party Respondents on or about April 30, 2006.
3. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are the current caregivers of Baby Doe, of whom the Petitioner is the natural father.
4. The Petitioner says that he has a legal right to the custody and care of Baby Doe, and wishes to lawfully pursue same as against the third-party caregivers, in addition to any other currently named respondents.
5. The Petitioner says that the third party caregivers ought to have standing in their own right in the within matter in order to fully participate in the determination of the issues raised in the Petition dated May 11, 2006, and in the Petitioner's subsequent court application(s).
