Re: Supervised visits of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

We were requested by the court to do supervised visits for the above mentioned parties. The first visit was on November 2, 2006. Everyone arrived at the designated time and the visit took place in the quiet room. [REDACTED] immediately got [REDACTED] out of the lounge seat and sat on the chesterfield smiling at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] started jumping on his lap. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then gave [REDACTED] the toys they had brought. While playing [REDACTED] would laugh and giggle and he seemed to be having an enjoyable time. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both took turns holding [REDACTED]. They also took some snap shots of them together. At one point [REDACTED] started to fuss so he was offered his bottle but he didn't want that. He took his soother and settled very quickly. [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] giggling and laughing playing with the toys. She noted that he had red gums and commented that he must be teething. [REDACTED] then changed his ([REDACTED]) diaper and [REDACTED] was checking him over. [REDACTED] wanted to see if he had a crooked baby toe which he said was a family trait. His toes were straight. They tried to give him the bottle again but [REDACTED] was content to play until the visit was over. Good-byes were said with lots of hugs and kisses.

November 6, 2006

Again everyone arrived on time. [REDACTED] held and cuddled [REDACTED] for a while. Then both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] talked and played with [REDACTED]. They brought many different toys for [REDACTED] to play with and he seemed to enjoy them as they played together. [REDACTED] took a picture of [REDACTED] sitting beside [REDACTED]. She also showed the supervising staff and [REDACTED] a blanket that a friend had made for him. [REDACTED] then gave [REDACTED] a diaper change. [REDACTED] was smiling, laughing and babbling through most of the visit as both played with him. At one point all three were on the floor, [REDACTED] on a blanket and

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they were playing. When he did fuss a tiny bit [redacted] picked him up and rocked with him. He settled so easily and they continued to play. When the visit was over they said their good-byes and gave kisses and hugs.

**November 13, 2006.**

Everyone arrived on time for the visit. Both [redacted] and [redacted] greeted [redacted] and were saying Hi!, how are you etc. [redacted] picked up [redacted] and gave him hugs and kisses. Barb had brought several different toys and [redacted] chose the one he wanted to play with. [redacted] sat on the floor with [redacted] and both [redacted] and [redacted] were playing and chatting with [redacted]. [redacted] had [redacted] jumping on her knees. [redacted] was laughing, smiling and talking baby talk all the while the visit went on. They took pictures of [redacted], changed his diaper, played peek a boo etc. When the visit was over they gave hugs and kisses. [redacted] stated that he hoped [redacted] would be home for Christmas.

**November 20, 2006.**

When [redacted] and [redacted] arrived for the visit our staff asked them not to wear perfume because [redacted] had mentioned that [redacted] seemed to have a reaction to this. [redacted] said that she did have perfume on and wouldn't wear it next time. [redacted] was very agreeable to this request. [redacted] was smiling and laughing with them. They brought a blanket to put on the floor and both played toys with [redacted]. They checked to see if he had any new teeth and were also amazed at how much he grows every week. After a the first half hour of the visit Liam was a bit fussy due to cutting teeth and both [redacted] and [redacted] took turns walking and comforting him. [redacted] did take a few pictures of [redacted] and [redacted]. When [redacted] and [redacted] picked up [redacted] they were taking him to the Doctor as he was not feeling well.

**November 27, 2006.**

When [redacted] arrived for the visit [redacted] let us know that he had a virus, was to the Doctor and he had a rough week between his teething and the virus. [redacted] was happy and cheerful when [redacted] and [redacted] arrived. They took him out of the baby chair, gave hugs and kisses and played with the little taal toys. [redacted] then laid [redacted] on his ([redacted]) tummy and he seemed quite content to lay there and giggle. When [redacted] started to fuss [redacted] fed him  $\frac{3}{4}$  of his bottle and he seemed very happy to be the center of attention. There was lots of smiles, he chewed on the toys and was very alert. They took a few pictures and then it was time for hugs and kisses and saying good-bye.

**November 30, 2006.**

As always everyone arrived on time. Staff carried [redacted] to the Quiet Room and handed him to [redacted]. [redacted] started to cry when [redacted] took him so he sat on the chesterfield with [redacted] on his knee and having him ([redacted]) facing out. [redacted] then showed [redacted] toys talked to him and seemed to have his attention and he settled in right away. [redacted] then got on the floor lying on his side and sat [redacted] facing him. [redacted] toppled over due to no support and started to cry. [redacted] immediately picked him up to soothe him but he continued to fuss. [redacted] got his bottle and [redacted] fed him

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when he had settled. After he had his bottle he started to cry again and [redacted] took [redacted] rocked him and talked softly swaying back and forth. [redacted] then changed his diaper and played with him as he had a diaper change. [redacted] then took [redacted] who bounced on his knee until the visit was over. They said their good-byes and left.

**December 4, 2006**

When [redacted] and [redacted] arrived staff handed [redacted] to [redacted] and they all went to the quiet room. Both [redacted] and [redacted] took turns cuddling, holding and talking to [redacted]. [redacted] checked [redacted]'s diaper but didn't change him. [redacted] started to fuss so [redacted] stood up and rocked him until he was settled. Both of them tried to feed him but he just wasn't hungry. They both tried to make sure [redacted] was happy, smiling and content. The visit ended with lots of kisses, hugs and see you.

**December 7, 2006**

Before all parties got to the Children's Haven we discovered that one of the children here had come down with Chicken Pox. Public Health was called and we discussed how to best handle the visit so [redacted] would not be exposed. [redacted] was informed of the Chicken Pox and he didn't feel there was much that could be done other than the precautions we were going to take for the visit to go ahead. When [redacted] and [redacted] arrived I informed [redacted] and he stated that he hadn't ever had them either but he didn't seem concerned. Our only concern was passing this to [redacted]. He was kept away from the other children and only in the office with me and in the quiet room for the visit. During the visit [redacted] took out toys they brought to play with [redacted]. Both [redacted] and [redacted] took turns holding and playing with him. [redacted] changed his diaper and [redacted] tried to give him a bottle which he didn't want. [redacted] jabbered in baby talk, smiled, laughed and appeared to be doing just fine during the whole visit. They took pictures of him as he played with [redacted] and [redacted]. When the visit was ended they said good-byes and gave kisses and hugs.

**December 11, 2006**

Everyone arrived on time for the visit. [redacted] picked up [redacted] and gave him a toy [redacted]'s mom had bought for him. Both played with him and took turns holding him. They put a blanket on the floor and both changed his diaper. [redacted] held [redacted] and tried to give him a bottle and again he wasn't hungry. They both took pictures of [redacted] with each other and then it was time to say goodbye.

During all of the visits [redacted] and [redacted] were very attentive towards [redacted] and his needs. They played appropriately with him for his age and gave him their full attention. [redacted] and [redacted] gave us information regarding how [redacted] was feeling, if he had just eaten etc.
