Thank you for your correspondence dated July 13, 2006.

We agree with you that, if possible, an amicable negotiation and settlement of this matter is preferable to "full-blown litigation as a means of resolving the case". Further, our clients have always indicated that they wish to be as cooperative as possible, in and for the best interests of the child.

Portions of your letter are somewhat puzzling to me, I must admit. I note from our early and previous telephone conversations, you had indicated that your client was not necessarily insistent on the relief requested in his materials. You indicated that he needed to know that the child was safe and healthy, and whether or not he was indeed the father, and then most likely some visitation or access with/to the child would suffice - and that we did not necessarily need to rip the child out of his home and from those who are caring most excellently for him. Are we still able to talk along these lines, or is your client insistent on the relief indicated in his materials?

We are not nearly as confident as you are that your client "will prove an excellent candidate in Court". Indeed, some very disturbing information has been provided to us concerning the Petitioner.
