Thank you for your correspondence of today's date concerning your client's first supervised through Children's Haven. We have been working diligently with our clients to do our part in facilitating the first supervised visit. Our clients advise that they are available to deliver the child for visits on Monday or Thursday or Saturday mornings. Children's Haven advises that they do not do visits on Saturdays, which leaves us with Monday mornings or Thursday mornings. Children's Haven advises that one hour visits start at 10 a.m. We therefore suggest fixing the weekly visit at either Monday morning 10 a.m. or Thursday morning 10 a.m.

Children's Haven advises that they have a number of requirements and procedures that must be complied with, including a lead time of several days before the first visit. We are under the impression then that Children's Haven must be satisfied that everything is in place before the first visit. We are not sure whether they will be ready for a first visit on this Thursday, October 19, 2006 or not.

Our clients have fulfilled all information and notification obligations on their part with Children's Haven.

Children's Haven advises that the custodial/residential parents and the access parent must first agree to a set of rules that will govern the supervised visits. The Haven has policies concerning this matter and have also advised our clients on matters that they need to address and provide instructions. We anticipate providing you with the suggested set of access rules tomorrow.

Please be assured that we are doing our best to facilitate the supervised access arrangement, but are encountering some significant preliminary matters. We trust that this is satisfactory and look forward to communicating with you in the next day or two.
